AN ACT

To fix the Salaries of the Executive Officers and
Employés of the Executive Department

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECT. 1. The governor, lieutenant-governor,
2 and members of the council shall receive per year,
3 and at the same rate for any fraction thereof, in
4 full compensation for their services, the following
5 sums, to wit:—

6 The governor, four thousand dollars; the
7 lieutenant-governor, two thousand five hundred
8 dollars; and members of the council, one thousand
9 dollars each.

1 SECT. 2. The private secretary of the gov-
2 ernor, and the messenger and assistant-messenger
3 in the executive department, shall receive per
4 year, and at the same rate for any fraction
5 thereof, in full compensation for their services,
6 the following sums, to wit:—

7 The private secretary, one thousand eight
8 hundred dollars; the messenger, nine hundred
9 dollars; and the assistant-messenger, seven hun-
10 dred and fifty dollars.

1 SECT. 3. All acts and parts of acts, incon-
2 sistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
