AN ACT

Concerning the Obstructions to the Passage of Fish in the tributaries of the Connecticut and Merrimack Rivers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECT. 1. The provisions of chapter two hun-
2 dred and thirty-eight of the acts of the year eigh-
3 teen hundred and sixty-six, and of chapter four
4 hundred and twenty-two of the acts of the year
5 eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, are hereby ex-
6 tended and shall apply to the tributaries of the
7 Connecticut and Merrimac rivers, within this Com-
8 monwealth.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
