AN ACT

To revive Chapter two hundred and forty-six of the Acts of the year eighteen hundred and seventy, relating to the Fitchburg Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECT. 1. Chapter two hundred and forty-six
2 of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
3 seventy, entitled, "An Act to authorize the Fitch-
4 burg Railroad Company to construct a Branch
5 Railroad," is hereby revived; and all the fran-
6 chises, rights, powers, authorities, privileges and
7 immunities granted by said act are hereby revived
8 and regranted to said company.

1 SECT. 2. The time within which said branch
2 railroad was required to be located is hereby ex-
3 tended two years, and the time for constructing
4 the same is extended three years from the passage
5 of this act.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
