In favor of Edward M. Steimle, of Boston.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid to private Edward M. Steimle, of company B, first battalion of cavalry, Massachusetts volunteer militia, the sum of five hundred dollars, in compensation for injuries received while doing military duty at Boston, on the seventeenth of June, eighteen hundred and seventy-five.
