AN ACT

To fix the Salary of the Clerk of the Second District Court of Bristol.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECT. 1. The clerk of the second district court
2 of Bristol, shall receive one thousand eight hun-
3 dred dollars per annum, in full compensation for
4 his own services and those of his assistants; com-
5 mencing with the first day of January in the
6 present year.

1 SECT. 2. The county treasurer, of the county
2 of Bristol, shall pay to the present clerk of said
3 court, the sum of seven hundred and ninety-two
4 dollars, to reimburse said clerk for moneys paid by
5 him to his assistants, up to the first day of said
6 January, under the direction of the justice of said
7 court, and with the advice of the district attorney.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from its
2 passage.
