Bill accompanying the petition of D. C. Murphy relative to the cleansing of receptacles used in serving beverages and ice cream. Public Health. January 2.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Cleansing of Receptacles used in Public Places for serving Beverages and Ice Cream.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All establishments where spirituous or in-
2 toxicating liquors are sold at retail and all drug stores,
3 confectionery stores and other places where ice cream or
4 soft drinks are dispensed to be drunk or eaten upon the
5 premises, shall be required to have hot and cold water for
6 the proper cleansing of the cups, saucers, glasses, spoons
7 and other articles used for dispensing such drinks and ice
8 cream.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall not apply
2 to places where only paper cups and saucers and indi-
3 vidual spoons are used instead of glass and metal utensils.

1 SECTION 3. Violation of the provisions of this act shall
2 be punished by a fine of not less than five nor more than
3 fifty dollars.

1 SECTION 4. Enforcement of the provisions of this act
2 shall be left to the state, city and town health depart-
3 ments.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect ninety days after
2 its passage.
