Bill accompanying the petition of Andrew J. Peters, mayor of the city of Boston, to authorize the city of Boston to make appropriations for municipal purposes. Metropolitan Affairs. January 10.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to make Appropriations for Municipal Purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston may by vote of the
2 city council with the approval of the mayor in the man-
3 ner provided in section three of chapter four hundred
4 and eighty-six of the acts of the year nineteen hundred
5 and nine make appropriations for municipal purposes
6 for the financial year not exceeding the following amounts
7 for the periods specified, to wit:—for the financial
8 year ending on the thirty-first day of January, nineteen
9 hundred and twenty, three dollars, for the financial
10 year ending on the thirty-first day of January, nineteen
11 hundred and twenty-one, two dollars, and for the fi-

12 nancial year ending on the thirty-first day of January,
13 nineteen hundred and twenty-two, one dollar on each
14 one thousand dollars of the valuations upon which the
15 appropriations by the city are based in addition to the
16 amounts which the city is authorized to appropriate
17 under the provisions of section fifty-three of Part I of
18 chapter four hundred and ninety of the acts of the year
19 nineteen hundred and nine, and all acts in amendment
20 thereof or in addition thereto.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
