

HOUSE No. 645

Bill accompanying the petition of John R. Nelson for the construction by the Metropolitan Park Commission of a dam and tide gate across Black's creek at its intersection with Furnace Brook parkway in the city of Quincy. Metropolitan Affairs. January 13.

AN ACT

To enable the Metropolitan Park Commission to construct a Dam and a Tide Gate in Furnace Brook Parkway where the Same crosses Black's Creek in the City of Quincy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commission is au-
2 thorized to construct a dam across Black's creek in the
3 city of Quincy where said creek is crossed by Furnace
4 Brook parkway and to hold the water above such dam at
5 such a level as said commission may deem advisable.
6 Said dam may be constructed with or without a tide
7 gate as said commission may decide. For the purpose of
8 carrying out this act said commission may expend, and
9 there is hereby appropriated the sum of dol-

10 lars from the Parkway Maintenance Fund assessed and
11 collected in accordance with the provisions of chapter
12 two hundred and eighty-eight of the acts of the year
13 eighteen hundred and ninety-four and chapter four hun-
14 dred and nineteen of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
15 and ninety-nine.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
