

HOUSE No. 676

Bill accompanying the petition of Leland Powers relative to fixing the salaries of certain employees of the Sergeant-at-Arms. Public Service. January 13.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen.

AN ACT

To fix the Salaries of the Doorkeepers, Assistant Doorkeepers, Postmaster and Messengers of the Senate and House of Representatives.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The salaries of the doorkeeper of the senate and of the
2 house of representatives shall hereafter be two thousand
3 dollars each. The assistant doorkeepers shall receive
4 seventeen hundred dollars, the postmaster eighteen hun-
5 dred dollars and the messengers of the senate and of the
6 house of representatives fifteen hundred dollars each.
