Bill accompanying the petition of the selectmen of the town of Watertown that the inspection of wires in buildings and of plumbing in said town be placed under the control of the inspector of buildings. Towns. January 13.

AN ACT

Relative to the Placing of the Inspection of Wires in Buildings and the Inspection of Plumbing in the Town of Watertown under the Control of the Inspector of Buildings in said Town.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The control and supervision of the in-
2 spector of wires of the town of Watertown, hereafter
3 appointed by the selectmen under section eighteen of
4 chapter one hundred twenty-two of the Revised Laws, in
5 so far as his duties and powers relate to the inspection of
6 wires in buildings in said town is hereby placed under the
7 inspector of buildings of said town.
