

Resolve accompanying the petition of William H. McDonnell for the planting of trees in memory of soldiers and sailors who died during the European war. Military Affairs. January 14.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen.

RESOLVE

To provide for the Planting of Trees in Memory of Soldiers
or Sailors dying in the Present War.

1 *Resolved*, That the sum of thousand dol-
2 lars is hereby appropriated to be paid out of the treasury
3 from the ordinary revenue to be expended by and under
4 the direction of the state forester for the purpose of
5 planting in cities and towns in the state fruit and shade
6 trees in memory of soldiers or sailors of such city or
7 town dying while in the service of the United States
8 government during the present war. Such trees shall be
9 marked with suitable tags or plates to designate what
10 soldier or sailor the tree is planted in memory of.
