## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen.

### AN ACT

In favor of granting Preference in Civil Service Examinations to those who served in the Army and Navy of the United States during the War with Germany.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. All persons who were enlisted in the  
2 army or navy of the United States during the war with  
3 Germany and possess an honorable discharge from said  
4 enlistment, shall, upon obtaining a passing mark in any  
5 examination held by the civil service commission, be  
6 placed at head of eligible list for position for which they  
7 were examined.

1 SECTION 2. The order in which they shall be placed  
2 at head of eligible list shall be according to percentage  
3 obtained in said examination.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
