Bill accompanying the petition of William H. McDonnell that persons discharged from the military or naval service of the United States be reinstated in the service of municipalities. Reconstruction. January 17.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen.

AN ACT

To provide for the Reinstatement of Soldiers and Sailors formerly in the Service of the Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Cities and towns shall reinstate in their
2 service all soldiers and sailors honorably discharged from
3 the service of the United States who were formerly in
4 their employ, without further civil service examination.

1 SECTION 2. So much of chapter nineteen of the Re-
2 vised Laws, and of any other act as is inconsistent here-
3 with is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect ninety days after
2 its passage.
