## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen.

### AN ACT

Directing the Secretary of the Commonwealth to furnish Certain Books and Documents to the Town of Medway.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The secretary of the commonwealth is hereby directed  
2 to furnish to the town of Medway, without cost to the  
3 town, a complete set of the reports of the decisions of the  
4 supreme judicial court, the index-digest thereof, a copy  
5 of the Revised Laws, and copies of all books and docu-  
6 ments now required to be furnished to towns by chapter  
7 nine of the Revised Laws and acts in amendment thereof  
8 and in addition thereto.
