### AN ACT

Relative to the Bonds required of Certain Officials and Employees of the Commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter two hundred and ninety-four of the General  
2 Acts of nineteen hundred and eighteen is hereby re-  
3 pealed. All provisions of law in any way repealed or  
4 modified by said chapter are hereby revived. Any  
5 separate bond given by any officer or employee of the  
6 commonwealth since the enactment of said chapter shall  
7 be deemed to be in all respects a valid obligation from  
8 the date of its execution notwithstanding anything con-  
9 tained in said chapter.
