

HOUSE No. 1767

Bill accompanying the petition of the park board of the city of New Bedford that said city be authorized to sell two parcels of park land no longer needed for public use. Cities. May 23.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of New Bedford to sell Realty acquired for Park Purposes but no longer Needed for Public Use.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of New Bedford may sell, at
2 public auction, two pieces of realty situated in said city
3 at the northeast corner of Rockdale avenue and Arnold
4 street, the same being a portion of property acquired for
5 park purposes but no longer necessary for public use, and
6 described as follows: beginning at the mentioned corner,
7 thence northerly in the east line of said Rockdale avenue,
8 one hundred eight-three and twenty-seven one hundredths
9 feet; thence southeasterly two hundred five and ninety
10 one hundredths feet to the north line of said Arnold
11 street; thence westerly in said north line of said street
12 seventy-eight and thirty-three one hundredths feet to the

13 place of beginning; containing seven thousand three
14 hundred sixty-seven and eighty-five one thousandths
15 square feet, more or less.

1 SECTION 2. The second parcel of land is bounded and
2 described as follows: beginning at the southeast corner
3 of Arnold street and Rockdale avenue, thence easterly in
4 said Arnold street ninety-nine and forty-seven one hun-
5 dredths feet; thence southeasterly in a diagonal line,
6 eighty-seven feet; thence westerly in a straight line, one
7 hundred thirty-three and ninety-one one hundredths
8 feet to the easterly line of Rockdale avenue; thence
9 northerly in the easterly line of Rockdale avenue, eighty-
10 one and five tenths feet to the point of beginning,
11 containing thirty-four and sixty-eight one hundredths
12 square rods.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
