RESOLVE

Granting a County Tax for the County of Bristol.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the following sums are hereby appropri-
2 ated for the expenses of the county of Bristol, for the
3 year nineteen hundred and nineteen:—
4 For interest on county debt, a sum not exceeding
5 thirty-two thousand dollars.
6 For reduction of county debt, a sum not exceeding
7 seventy-three thousand five hundred dollars.
8 For salaries of county officers and assistants, fixed by
9 law, a sum not exceeding thirty-five thousand dollars.
10 For clerical assistance in county offices, a sum not ex-
11 ceeding twenty-four thousand dollars.
12 For salaries and expenses of district and police courts,
13 a sum not exceeding seventy-six thousand dollars.
14 For salaries of jailers, masters and assistants, and
15 support of prisoners in jails and houses of correction, a
16 sum not exceeding one hundred and ten thousand dollars.
17 For criminal costs in the superior court, a sum not
18 exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars.
19 For civil expenses in the supreme judicial and superior
20 courts, a sum not exceeding twenty-one thousand dollars.
21 For transportation expenses of county and associate
22 commissioners, a sum not exceeding eight hundred dollars.

23 For medical examiners, inquests, and commitments of
24 the insane, a sum not exceeding twelve thousand dollars.

25 For auditors, masters and referees, a sum not exceeding
26 three thousand dollars.

27 For repairing, furnishing and improving county build-
28 ings, a sum not exceeding twelve thousand dollars.

29 For fuel, lights and supplies in county buildings, other
30 than jails and houses of correction, and for care of the
31 same, a sum not exceeding thirty-nine thousand dollars.

32 For highways, including state highways, bridges and
33 land damages, a sum not exceeding twenty-six thousand
34 dollars.

35 For law libraries, a sum not exceeding six thousand
36 one hundred dollars.

37 For training school, a sum not exceeding twelve thou-
38 sand dollars.

39 For pensions, a sum not exceeding three thousand
40 dollars.

41 For miscellaneous and contingent expenses of the cur-
42 rent year, a sum not exceeding two thousand five hun-
43 dred dollars.

44 For agricultural school, a sum not exceeding thirty-
45 five thousand dollars.

46 And the county commissioners of said county are
47 hereby authorized to levy as the county tax of said
48 county for the current year, in the manner provided by
49 law, the sum of four hundred and sixty-three thousand
50 four hundred dollars, to be expended, together with the
51 cash balance on hand and the receipts from other sources,
52 for the above purposes.
