**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT TO INFORM THE PUBLIC OF POWERS OF THE BOARDS OF REGISTRATION WITHIN THE DIVISION OF REGISTRATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 112 shall be amended by adding the following  
2 section: —

3 §-61-A: Any person, or group when appropriate to do so,  
4 registered, certified, or licensed pursuant to the provisions of  
5 Chapter 112, Chapter 141, or Chapter 142 shall post in a  
6 conspicuous place in his business establishment, or office, and  
7 printed on the back of any bill submitted to a client, patient, or  
8 customer, the following statement completed appropriately:
