In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT REQUIRING DEPOSIT OF ASSESSORS' VALUATION BOOK, WITH THE COMMISSIONER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 59 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 49, as amended by section 3 of chapter 532 of the acts
3 of 1969, and inserting in place thereof the following section:—
4 *Section 49.* The assessors, except those of Boston, on or before
5 July first, nineteen hundred and sixty, and in every fifth year
6 thereafter or more frequently if required by the commissioner,
7 shall deposit in the office of the commissioner, a copy of the
8 assessors' valuation books of those years, to be by them certified
9 under oath.
