AN ACT RECLASSIFYING THE CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF LEOMINSTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 79 of chapter 218 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in section 1 of chapter 668 of the acts of 1971, is
3 hereby amended by striking out in paragraph (1) under Class IV
4 the words "district court of Leominster".

1 SECTION 2. Said section 79 of chapter 218 is hereby further
2 amended by inserting in said paragraph (1) under Class I, after
3 the words "district court of Lawrence" the following words:—
4 district court of Leominster.
