ASN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE TERM "FEDERAL SERVICE PERSONNEL".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 103B of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in chapter 783 of the acts of 1971, is hereby amended by striking
3 out, in line 4, the words "and citizens of the United States
4 temporarily residing outside the territorial limits of the United
5 States and the District of Columbia" and inserting in their place
6 the following:—

7 and citizens of the United States temporarily living outside the
8 commonwealth.
