

By Mr. Brownell of Quincy, petition of Thomas F. Brownell, Peter C. McCarthy, Robert S. Teahan and Paul F. X. Moriarty for legislation to prohibit the construction of additional sewerage facilities on Nut Island in the city of Quincy. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE CONSTRUCTION OF ADDITIONAL SEWERAGE FACILITIES ON NUT ISLAND IN THE CITY OF QUINCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, neither
2 the metropolitan district commission nor any political subdivi-
3 sion of the commonwealth may construct an additional
4 sewerage treatment plant or expand existing sewerage treatment
5 facilities at the existing Nut Island facility in the city of Quincy in
6 a manner which involves substantial land fill operations or the
7 filling in of Quincy Bay. Anything involving more than the filling
8 in of more than two acres of land will be irrebuttably and
9 inclusively presumed to cause irreparable damage to Quincy and
10 the environment.
