AN ACT PROVIDING FREE SPORTING LICENSES FOR CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 11 of chapter 131 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 1 of chapter 420 of the Acts of 1974, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out the last sentence of the second
4 paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following
5 sentence: — No fee shall be charged for any license issued under
6 this paragraph to a person over the age of sixty-five, or for a
7 fishing or hunting license issued under this paragraph to a
8 paraplegic, or for a fishing license issued under this paragraph to
9 a person who is blind or metally retarded.
