AN ACT TO GRANT A REAL ESTATE TAX EXEMPTION TO CERTAIN PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first sentence of clause forty-first of section 5 of chapter 59
2 of the General Laws as amended by chapter 1069 of the Acts of
3 1971 and chapter 456 of the Acts of 1970 is hereby further
4 amended by striking out the words "70 years of age or over" and
5 inserting in place thereof in each instance the words: — 65 years
6 of age or over.
