### AN ACT REVISING DEPENDENCY BENEFIT LIMITS IN PAYMENT OF UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 151A, section 29(c) of the General Laws as most
- 2 recently amended is hereby amended by striking out the words
- 3 "six dollars" as they appear in the first sentence of said section
- 4 29(c) and inserting the words "twelve dollars" in their place.
