AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CONTINUATION OF GROUP ACCIDENT AND HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES WHEN CONVERTED TO AN INDIVIDUAL POLICY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 110 of chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after paragraph (f) the following para-
3 graph: —

4 (g) Any company providing a blanket or general policy issued
5 under this section shall provide for a continuation of coverage
6 without lapse of benefits when an individual converts said blanket
7 or general policy to an individual policy.
