AN ACT PROHIBITING PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN FROM TRAPPING ANIMALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 11 of chapter 131 of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 706 of the acts
3 of 1972, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 18, 19 and 20,
4 the words "except that for such license issued to a minor twelve to
5 seventeen years of age, inclusive, the fee shall be six dollars and
6 twenty-five cents," and inserting in place thereof the following: —
7 except that a trapping license shall not be issued to any person
8 under the age of eighteen.
