AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PLYMOUTH COUNTY TO BORROW ADDITIONAL MONEY FOR CONSTRUCTING, EQUIPPING AND FURNISHING THE FOURTH DISTRICT COURT OF PLYMOUTH AT WAREHAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purposes set forth in Chapter 965 of the  
2 Acts of 1973, except planning, the County Commissioner of  
3 Plymouth County are authorized to borrow an additional One  
4 Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars so that limitation upon  
5 the total costs of construction, equipping and furnishing said  
6 facility shall be increased to Two Million, Three Hundred  
7 Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes authorized by Section 1, the  
2 Treasurer of said County, with the approval of the County  
3 Commissioners, may borrow such sums as may be necessary, not  
4 exceeding, in the aggregate, One Hundred Twenty-Five Thou-  
5 sand Dollars, in addition to sums authorized under the provisions  
6 of Chapter 965 of the Acts of 1973, and may issue bonds or notes  
7 of the County therefor, which shall bear on their face the words  
8 "Fourth District Court of Plymouth, Court House Loan, Act of  
9 1977".
