AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING PERSONS ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF DIGGING OR DRILLING WELLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 21 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 out Section 16 as appearing in Chapter 513 of the Acts of 1962
3 and by inserting in place thereof the following:—

4 *Section 16.* No person shall engage in the business of digging
5 or drilling wells within the Commonwealth unless he has received
6 a permit from the Water Resources Commission. No person shall
7 engage in the business of digging or drilling wells within the
8 Commonwealth unless he has received a certificate of registration
9 from the Water Resources Commission, for which an annual fee
10 of ten dollars is required or until said Commission has
11 determined that the water supply is adequate.
