AN ACT TO LIMIT EXPENSES ALLOWED CONSULTING COMPANIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 7, section 14B is hereby amended by adding at the end
2 thereof the following:—

3 No contract to provide consultant services shall be awarded by
4 the Commonwealth, or by any department, board, commission or
5 other agency acting in its behalf, unless the person signing such
6 contract on behalf of the party contracting to provide such
7 services agrees to private mileage, breakfast, lunch and dinner
8 compensation not exceeding the rate that employees of the
9 Commonwealth of Massachusetts are paid.
