AN ACT REQUIRING SEVEN DAYS NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING OF BILLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notice of public hearings of legislative committees shall be
2 published not less than seven (7) days prior to the date of said
3 hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the com-
4 monwealth; said notice shall include but not be limited to the
5 date, time and place of said hearing and the general subject
6 matter.
