

HOUSE No. 1149

By Mr. Cusack of Arlington, petition of John F. Cusack that the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority be prohibited from constructing extensions of the Red Line without prior local approval. Transportation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FROM CONSTRUCTING EXTENSIONS OF THE RED LINE WITHOUT PRIOR LOCAL APPROVAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority is hereby
2 prohibited from constructing any extension of rapid transit
3 facilities along the red line, so called, to a terminus at or near state
4 route 128, unless approval therefor is first obtained from the
5 selectmen or council of each town or city, as the case may be,
6 through which any such extension may pass.
