AN ACT TO PUT MASSACHUSETTS HOUSING AUTHORITIES UNDER THE EMPLOYER UNFAIR LABOR PRACTICE ACT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 29 of chapter 121B as last amended by chapter 286 of  
2 the Acts of 1973 is hereby amended by striking the fourth  
3 paragraph of said section and replacing that paragraph with the  
4 following paragraph:—

5 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary the  
6 provisions of sections four and five of chapter one hundred and  
7 fifty A shall apply to said authorities and their employees.
