By Mr. Shea of Worcester, petition of C. Vincent Shea that provision be made for the disposition of fines and penalties in violation of rules and regulations on the campuses of community colleges. Education.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSITION OF FINES AND PENALTIES IN VIOLATION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS ON THE CAMPUSES OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 15 of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 331 of
2 the acts of 1972, is hereby further amended by striking out the
3 third sentence and inserting in place thereof the following
4 sentence: — Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all fines
5 and penalties recovered for violation of rules and regulations
6 made under authority of this section shall be accounted for by the
7 clerk of the court and forwarded to the president of the
8 community college where rules and regulations have been
9 violated, who shall deposit such fines or penalties in a special
10 fund, which shall accrue and be used for the benefit of the
11 students enrolled therein.
