AN ACT RELATIVE TO ASSAULT AND BATTERY UPON POLICE OFFICERS OR FIRE FIGHTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 13D of chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by deleting the words "imprisonment for not less than
3 ten days nor more than two and one-half years in a house of
4 correction or by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars nor
5 more than five hundred dollars", and substituting the following
6 "imprisonment for not less than thirty days nor more than four
7 years in a house of correction or by a fine of not less than five
8 hundred dollars nor more than one thousand dollars".
