AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A SPEEDY TRIAL OF A MISDEMEANOR BY A JURY OF SIX IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF MARLBOROUGH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 27A of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in chapter 620 of the acts of 1972, is hereby amended by striking
3 out the sixth paragraph and inserting in place thereof the
4 following paragraph:—

5 Any defendant in the district court of Marlborough, the district
6 court of Natick, first district court of Southern Middlesex, the
7 district court of Central Middlesex or the second district court of
8 Eastern Middlesex found guilty of an offence or crime over which
9 the district courts have original jurisdiction under the provisions
10 of section twenty-six may appeal and claim a jury of six in the
11 first district court of Southern Middlesex or the district court of
12 Marlborough.
