AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED BICYCLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1B of chapter 90 of the General Laws,
2 inserted by section 4 of chapter 261 of the acts of 1976, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the second sentence.

1 SECTION 2. Section 8B of said chapter 90 is hereby amended
2 by striking out the fourth sentence, as appearing in section 5 of
3 said chapter 261 and inserting in place thereof the following
4 sentence: — A motorcycle learner's permit which has expired
5 shall be renewed, without examination, at the discretion of the
6 registrar.
