AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES AND CERTIFICATES OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY FOR SIGHT-SEEING MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 399 of the acts of 1931 is hereby amended
2 by striking out Section 1 and inserting in place thereof the
3 following section: —

4 *Section 1.* The term "sight-seeing automobile", as used in this
5 act, shall mean an automobile, as defined in section one of
6 chapter ninety of the General Laws, used for the carrying for a
7 consideration of persons for sight-seeing purposes in the city of
8 Boston when such carriage originates in the city of Boston or in a
9 city or town which is contiguous to the city of Boston and in or on
10 which automobile guide service by the driver or other person is
11 offered or furnished.

1 SECTION 2. Section 2, 5 and 6 of chapter 399 of the acts of
2 1931 are hereby amended by striking out in the first sentence of
3 each such section the words "in or from the city of Boston," and
4 by striking out further in section 2 the words "in or from said
5 city," and by striking out further in the fourth sentence of Section
6 5, the words "carrying persons in or from the city of Boston."
