*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 Chapter 1078 of the acts of 1973 is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 4 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 4A.* For purposes of collective bargaining, the chief of
- 4 police of a city or town shall be considered management
- 5 personnel.
