AN ACT INCREASING THE MEAL ALLOWANCES FOR CERTAIN STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section seven of chapter twenty-eight A of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the second paragraph thereof
3 the following new paragraph:

4 "Said rules and regulations shall provide reimbursement for
5 actual meal expenses incurred, including tips, not to exceed the
6 following:
