AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME IN WHICH THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY MUST GRANT THE EMPLOYEE A HEARING UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW AND RULES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 43(e) of Chapter 31 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by deleting the word "five" in line 16 and
3 inserting in place thereof the word "ten".

1 SECTION 2. Section 43 (g) of Chapter 31 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by deleting the word "five" in line 9 and
3 inserting in place thereof the word "ten".
