AN ACT CLARIFYING THE STATUTES REGULATING COMPETITIVE BIDDING IN THE AWARD OF CONTRACTS FOR PUBLIC BUILDING PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph 1 of Section 44G of Chapter 149 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by adding the following after the word
3 certifies: "That he customarily performs this sub-trade with
4 persons on his own payroll and".

5 Paragraph 1 to read as follows: — "The undersigned hereby
6 certifies that he customarily performs this sub-trade with persons
7 on his own payroll and that he is able to furnish labor that can
8 work in harmony with all other elements of labor employed or to
9 be employed on the work."
