By Mr. Duffin of Lenox, petition of Henry G. Greiner, Dennis J. Duffin and others for the payment from the State Treasury of a sum of money to the town of Lee for part of the cost of construction of an addition to a school house. Ways and Means (joint).

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE TOWN OF LEE OF PART OF THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADDITION TO A SCHOOLHOUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay to
2 the town of Lee such sums as would have been due said town
3 from the commonwealth, if an application for a state school
4 construction grant for the construction by said town of an
5 addition of a junior high school wing to the Lee central school
6 had been filed by said town and approved by the board of
7 education under the provisions of chapter six hundred and forty-
8 five of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-eight, as amended.
9 Said board shall determine the amounts and the time of said
10 payments shall certify the same to the comptroller as provided in
11 said chapter six hundred and forty-five, and the treasurer shall
12 make the payments so certified to said town.
