AN ACT PROHIBITING DISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF STATUS AS A STUDENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 151B of the General Laws, most
2 recently amended by c. 483 of the Acts of 1974, is hereby
3 amended as follows:

4 1. Clauses 6, 8, and 9 of Section 3 of Chapter 151B are
5 amended by inserting after the word "ancestry" in sentence one of
6 each clause the phrase "or student status."

7 2. Clause 13 of Section 3 of Chapter 151B is amended by
8 inserting after the phrase "economic level," the phrase "or student
9 status."

10 3. Clauses 1, 2, 3A and 3B of Section four of Chapter 151B are
11 amended by inserting after the word "ancestry" the phrase "or
12 student status."

13 4. Clause 6(a), 6(b), and 6(c) of Section four of Chapter 151B
14 are amended by inserting after the word "blind" the phrase "or a
15 student."

16 5. Clauses 7(a), 7(b), and 7(c), and clauses 8(1), 8(2), 8(3), of
17 Chapter 151B are amended by inserting after the phrase "marital
18 status" the phrase "or student status."

19 6. Clauses 13(a) and 13(b) of Section four of Chapter 151B are
20 amended by inserting after the phrase "economic level" the phrase
21 "or student status."

22 7. Clause 14 of Section four of Chapter 151B is amended by
23 inserting after the phrase "marital status" the phrase "or student
24 status."

25 8. Section 9 of Chapter 151B is amended by inserting after the
26 word "ancestry" the phrase "or student status."

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall become effective on the first day
2 of August, 1977.
