## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT REQUIRING A CREDITOR WHO REPOSSESSES A MOTOR VEHICLE TO NOTIFY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OR TOWN IN WHICH THE REPOSSESSION OCCURRED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 255B of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after section 20B the following section: —

3 *Section 20C.* Any creditor obtaining possession of a motor  
4 vehicle under the provisions of this chapter shall within one hour  
5 after obtaining such possession notify the police department of  
6 the city or town in which such possession occurred, giving such  
7 police department a brief description of the vehicle involved.
