## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING NOTICE REQUIREMENT UNDER THE WETLANDS ACT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 40 of chapter 131 of the General Laws as most recently  
2 amended by chapter 818 of the Acts of 1974, is hereby further  
3 amended by striking the second sentence of the eleventh  
4 paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following: —

5 Notice of the time and place of said hearing shall be given by  
6 the hearing authority at the expense of the applicant, not less than  
7 five days prior to such hearing, by publication in a newspaper of  
8 general circulation in the city or town where the activity is  
9 proposed and by mailing a notice to the applicant, to all abutters,  
10 and to the board of health and the planning board of said city or  
11 town and to the department of environmental quality engineering  
12 and the department of public works.
