AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE UNIFORM OF SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 147 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 10J thereof the following section: —

3 *Section 10K.* No special police officer, licensed by the com-
4 missioner of public safety, police commissioner or chief of police
5 of any city or town shall wear a uniform identifiable to that worn
6 by a police officer in the city or town in which said special officers
7 are working. Violation of this section shall constitute cause to
8 revoke the license of any special police officer in violation hereof
9 and shall constitute cause to revoke the license of any private
0 detective, watch, guard, or patrol agency or business licensed
1 under section twenty-five of this chapter which employs a special
2 police officer in violation of this section.
