*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The first sentence of section 2 of Chapter 48 of

3 by Chapter 13 of the Acts of 1972, and by Chapter 248 of the Acts
