## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT TO RESTRICT THE EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION BETWEEN STATE AGENCIES OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS AND THE PRIVATE, FRENCH-BASED GROUP, INTERPOL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. As used in this chapter an "agency" shall be  
2 defined as the Commonwealth or any of its departments,  
3 authorities established by the General Court to serve a public  
4 purpose having either state-wide or local jurisdiction, boards, and  
5 commissions or other entities.

1 SECTION 2. No agency within the Commonwealth of  
2 Massachusetts may give or receive any data on any citizen of the  
3 United States, any alien, or any group, organization, or  
4 corporation, based in the United States or abroad, to or from  
5 INTERPOL.
