AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN LICENSES ISSUED TO CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, any
- 2 person sixty-five years of age or older no longer actively engaged
- 3 in a profession, trade, or calling who has paid fees for at least
- 4 twenty-five consecutive years for a license to engage in such work,
- 5 shall be issued a license for such purpose without charge.
